GENERAL INFORMATION

5-19-5 VEG PRODUCER is formulated to be used in most soil and foliar applications or applied through a drip system.

5-19-5 VEG PRODUCER has a low salt index and is readily absorbed by the plant tissue to provide rapid translocation to the deficient points.

Caution- Do not apply when the crop is excessively stressed for moisture or during periods of high temperatures. Do not apply to run off. Do not apply with conventional products including salts, spray oils, non-chelated metals, or sulfates. Do add, as a minimum, equal amounts of water. Use sufficient water to provide thorough coverage

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOLIAR RATES

Nut and Deciduous fruit tree crops, vine crops, vegetable and field crops:
Use 1 to 3 gallons per acre up to 3 times per season.

Citrus and Avacodo:

Use 1 to 4 gallons per acre up to 3 times per season.

SOIL RATES

Transplant water All Crops:

Use 1 to 4 gallons per acre in 500 to 1000 gals. of water per acre

Drip Irrigation All Crops:

Use 3 to 10 gallons per acre per irrigation. Continue irrigation for a minimum of two hours to maximize fertilizer distribution.

All Direct Seeded Crops and Field Crops:

Use 1-3 gallons per acre banded in the seedbed but not in direct contact with the seed. On light textured or sandy soils, use 1 TO 2 gallons per acre.

Caution- Do not apply directly on the seed. Adequate soil moisture must be available to avoid germination problems.
